Addendum to Special Meeting Minutes Held on May 13, 2026
Regarding Applicability of Charter § 24(b)

On May 13, 2026, the Prudential Committee unanimously voted, pursuant to Charter § 24(a), to discontinue any and all Fire District recognition and maintenance responsibility for a specified portion of sidewalk located from the Northern boundary of the Daniel residence, South along Route 66, to Furnace Street. This action did not close the sidewalk, restrict public access, assess costs, award damages, or impose any financial obligation on any landowner or resident.

Charter § 24(b) applies only in circumstances where the Prudential Committee undertakes the making, altering, or repairing of sidewalks and assesses owners or occupants of benefited land for a portion of the expense following notice and hearing. As no assessment of benefits, costs, or damages was undertaken or contemplated in connection with this vote, Charter § 24(b) is not applicable.

The Committee's action constituted an administrative discontinuance of District maintenance responsibility under Charter § 24(a) *only*, for which no additional notice or hearing beyond compliance with Vermont's Open Meeting Law is required.
